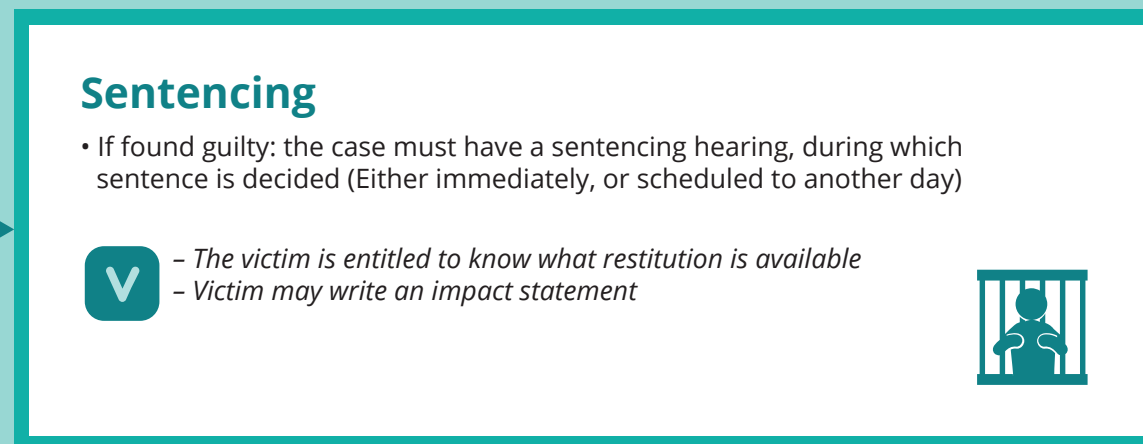
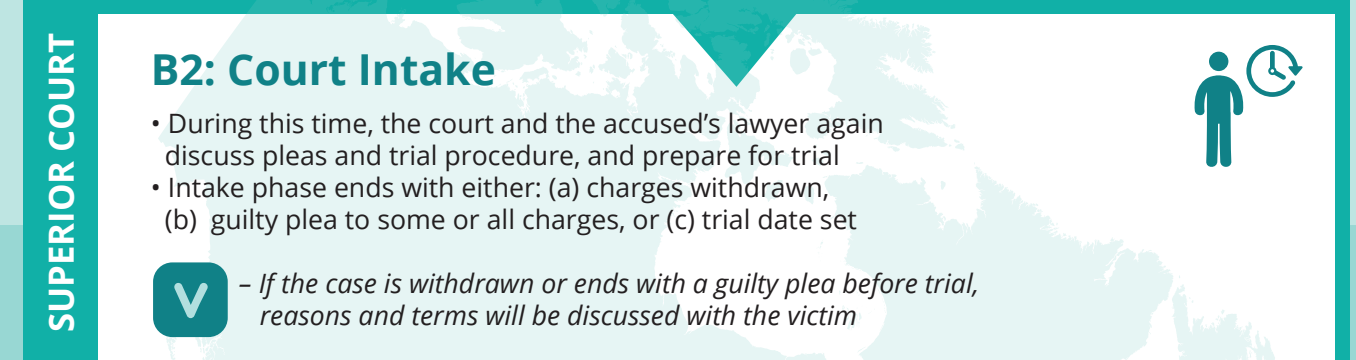
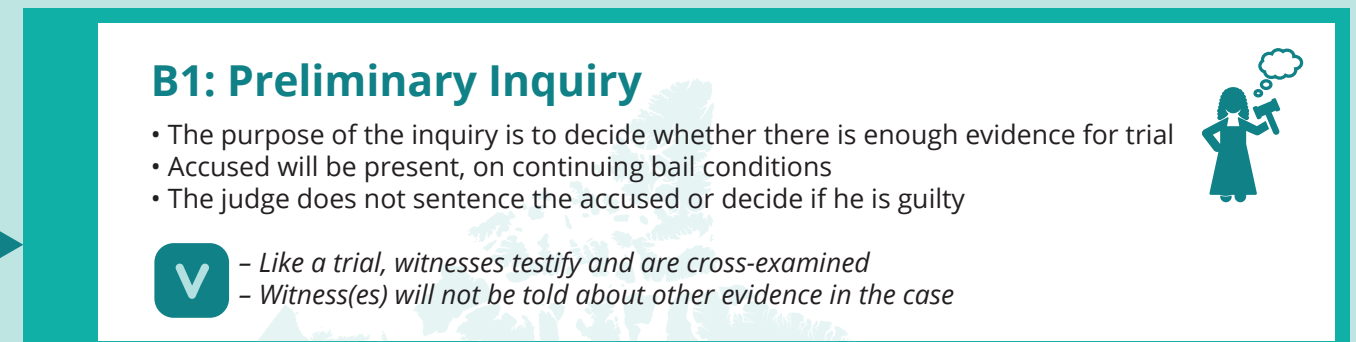
WHAT HAPPENS FIRST?



PROVINCIAL COURT *Normally less than 12 month period*



SUPERIOR COURT *Longer process that includes a preliminary inquiry as well as the trial*
